G Co conducts Operation Air Wolf IV

ZABUL, Afghanistan- Soldiers from G Company of 3rd Squadron, 2nd Stryker Cavalry Regiment recently took the fight to the enemy during an air assault mission conducted Thursday, Feb 17. Ghost rider and their Afghan National Army counterparts from the 6/3/205 searched the mountain villages of Haji Mohammed Khan Kalay and Pa'in Kalay in the Helmand Province.

The partnered units using attached military tactical explosive detection dog teams searched over 50 compounds in the two villages. Their thorough efforts proved successful in uncovering a cache of IED making materials. The teams also safely uncovered and detonated two IED devices. While preparing to leave, Soldiers of Ghost rider and their ANA counterparts indentified and questioned seven individuals who appeared to be signaling each other with mirrors as the Soldiers prepared to depart from the objective.

It is partnered patrols such as these that continue to reinforce a government security presence in areas that have been known as insurgent safe zones in the past.
