Honoring a Hero: Lt. Col. Kendric Robbins, Commander of 1st Squadron, 2nd Cavalry Regiment, (Lft) presents Pvt. Braden Tucker the Purple Heart Friday, Nov. 4, for injuries he sustained during his recent deployment to Afghanistan. Tucker was wounded when an Improvised Explosive device went off during a mounted patrol from Combat Operations Post Tabor on Jan. 5, 2011 near Tarin Kowt in Uruzguan Province, Afghanistan. Tucker sustained wounds to his face and head as a result of the shrapnel.
